Organizations	Project Description
Belmont Heights Community Association	To fund research, home tours, an illustrated book or booklet, website, and an exhibit on Miner Smith at the Historical Society of Long Beach.
Rancho Los Alamitos	To fund the restoration of the Cook's bedroom and hallway in the historic Rancho Los Alamitos ranch house.
Rowan Bradley Building	To restore the mezzanine windows along Broadway and Pine to the original design; restore three large storefront windows along Broadway; design a new entrance for a restaurant; reuse the existing blade sign; and provide for new surface exterior to match the existing color and texture.
City of Long Beach	To fund a restoration and long-term maintenance plan for the Recreation Park Bandshell.
University Art Museum, CSULB	To fund conservation of J.J. Beljon's monumental sculpture, Homage to Sam Rodia, 1965.
